In Nepali culture, Shrawan is devoted to Lord Shiva and the first day is marked as Sawane Sankranti. This first day of Shrawan features family gatherings and celebrations. During Shrawan women of all ages celebrate Shiva by wearing green, fasting for long life and harmony.



Gai Jatra is a festival in Kathmandu Valley celebrating loved ones who have passed away. Families send children dressed as cows to parade in the streets, symbolizing remembrance and easing grief.

"Gai" means cow and is considered a goddess symbolizing wealth in Hinduism.



Janai Purnima is a Hindu festival with family feasts of Kwati and men renewing their Janai. People visit Shiva temples and observe Shaman culture, performing rites at Kumbeshwar in Patan, Gosaikunda in Langtang, and Charikot in Dolakha.



Krishna Ashtami celebrates Lord Krishna's birthday. He is revered as a manifestation of Lord Vishnu, known for teaching the value of karma to Arjuna in the Bhagavad Gita.



Teej is a three-day festival celebrated by women in Nepal around August or September. Women wear red sarees and accessories, sing folk songs, and dance. Married women are invited to their maternal homes for feasting, making Teej a significant occasion.



Indra Jatra is an eight-day festival in September, cherished by the Newar community in Kathmandu Valley. It kicks off the autumn festival season with the erection of a pine pole at Basantapur Square, by the old Hanuman Dhoka Palace.





TASK FORCE RECOMMENDS MONETISATION OF TIA TO RAISE FUNDS FOR NIJGADH AIRPORT



A government task force has recommended monetizing Tribhuvan International Airport (TIA) property to fund the construction of an international airport in Nijgadh.

The task force suggests using a lease, operation, and transfer (LOT) model under a Public-Private Partnership (PPP). The recommended company should have experience in asset monetization, have operated at least one international airport under the LOT model, and possess assets of at least USD 1 billion.

The report also highlights that 25 Indian airports under the Airports Authority of India are set for asset monetization from 2022 to 2025 through India's National Monetization Pipeline. Thirteen of these airports will be developed, managed, and operated via the PPP model.

Bhubaneswar, Varanasi, Amritsar, Trichy, Indore, Calicut, Coimbatore, Nagpur, Patna, Madurai, Udaipur, Dehradun, Rajahmundry airports are in this pipeline.

The Airports Authority of India has identified 13 airports to be operated, managed and developed through the PPP model.

IATA REPORTS 97% PASSENGER SATISFACTION



The International Air Transport
Association (IATA) reveals that the
world's airlines are delivering a satisfactory
experience to 97% of their passengers.
This is a vast improvement over the early
post-pandemic period. The IATA Passenger
Survey was conducted between March 29
and April 14, 2024, surveying the 6,500
passengers using air travel in the last 12
months. The survey showed that 97% of
these passengers were satisfied flying
through various IATA member carriers.

The responses included from air travellers in Australia, Canada, Chile, France, Germany, India, Japan, Singapore, the United Arab Emirates, the United Kingdom, the United States, the Netherlands, Indonesia, Spain and China.

Likewise, IATA's April traffic report shows that global passenger demand, as measured by revenue passenger kilometres (RPKs), grew 11% year-on-year. The report demonstrates that in April, the number of available seat kilometres (ASKs) grew by 9.6% and the passenger load factor increased to 82.4%, a one percentage point improvement compared to April 2023. Of the world's regions, Europe had the highest load factor of 83.8%, followed by North America (83.0%), Asia-Pacific (82.4%), Latin America (82.2%), Middle East (79.2%) and Africa (73.4%).

NEPAL GOVERNMENT ALLOCATES RS 3.77 BILLION FOR CIVIL AVIATION DEVELOPMENT IN FY 2081-82 BUDGET

In the upcoming budget for 2081-82, the government of Nepal has allocated Rs 3.77 billion for the development of civil aviation infrastructure. Key initiatives include the commencement of construction for a second terminal at Tribhuvan International Airport and the expansion of Bharatpur Airport, with NPR 360 million allocated for completion next year.

The Nijgadh International Airport is planned for construction through a public-private partnership in the next financial year. Additionally, non-operational domestic airports like Lamidanda, Manang, Rumjatar, and Baitadi will be repurposed for adventure tourism activities, including paragliding, parachuting, sky diving, and ultralight flights.

TIA TO CLOSE FOR 10 HOURS DAILY FROM NOVEMBER

Tribhuvan International Airport (TIA) in Kathmandu will undergo significant operational changes starting November 8, as announced by the TIA office. To facilitate crucial infrastructure upgrades, including runway, taxiway, and parking bay extension, the airport will close for 10 hours daily from 10 PM to 8 AM. This schedule will be in effect for five months, ending on March 31.

During this period, TIA will reduce its operating hours to 14 hours a day, compared to its current schedule of 6 AM to 2 AM. This temporary adjustment is necessary to accommodate the extensive construction work required to enhance the airport's facilities, the airport office shared in a statement.

The nighttime closure will necessitate airlines to revise their flight schedules, potentially affecting both international and domestic flights. Passengers are advised to stay informed about changes to their travel plans and coordinate with their respective airlines.

EXPENSIVE AIRFARES IMPACTING TOURIST ARRIVALS IN NEPAL

n the first half of 2024, nearly 600,000 foreign tourists visited Nepal, with the Nepal Tourism Board (NTB) reporting an actual figure of 583,016. Despite an overall improvement in tourist arrivals compared to the previous year, a notable decrease was observed in June, following a peak in March and April, considered prime months for mountain climbing and trekking.



March and April saw tourist numbers exceeding 100,000 per month, but this trend did not continue into May. According to NTB data, tourist arrivals in June dropped to 76,736 from 90,211 in May.

Tourism entrepreneurs expressed that the price hike of airfares post government charging 13% VAT on flight tickets has contributed to such decline.

They have a view that several contributing factors to the high airfare costs, including the government's inclusion of a 13% Value Added Tax (VAT) on air tickets, elevated airport parking fees, and the overall high price of air travel. They believe that until these costs are reduced, significant improvements in tourist arrivals will be unlikely.

US LAWMAKERS STRIKE DEAL TO BOOST AVIATION SAFETY, WILL NOT RAISE PILOT RETIREMENT AGE

US House and Senate negotiators reached a deal to increase air traffic controller staffing and funding to prevent runway incidents. However, they decided against raising the airline pilot retirement age from 65 to 67, despite the House's earlier vote in favour.

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NEPAL'S AIRPORTS HAVE INTRODUCED SEVERAL INITIATIVES TO ENHANCE PASSENGER EXPERIENCES, PANDEY



Hansha Raj Pandey, the Deputy Director General of the Civil Aviation Authority of Nepal (CAAN), also serves as the spokesperson and a member of the authority's management team. Our team from Himalaya Airlines recently met with him in his office at CAAN to discuss the latest updates on the Nepali aviation industry. Below are excerpts from what he shared.

Nepal's aviation sector has experienced significant advancements recently, focusing on modernizing its infrastructure to enhance international connectivity. Key areas of development include:

MODERNIZATION OF AVIATION INFRASTRUCTURE:

Infrastructural
Developments: Major
airports, including Tribhuvan
International Airport (TIA),
are undergoing substantial
expansions and upgrades.
Efforts include terminal
expansion, runway safety
initiatives like runway/taxiway
upgrades, runway extensions,
improved airfield lighting, and
the installation of precision
navigation systems.

Improved Facilitation: TIA has enhanced passenger facilities, featuring improved check-in counters, security screening, baggage handling, and waiting areas. Additional upgrades include new parking facilities, upgraded lounges, and the provision of free Wi-Fi and charging stations.

Ground Services: Upgrades in ground support services and infrastructure encompass fueling stations, maintenance facilities, and airport logistics, aiming to streamline operations and reduce turnaround times.

Similarly, to reduce the burden on TIA and promote regional development,
Nepal marked a significant achievement in its aviation

history by inaugurating its second international airport outside of the capital on May 16, 2022. Located in Lumbini, Gautam Buddha International Airport (GBIA) features a harmonious blend of modernity and functionality. The airport boasts stateof-the-art infrastructure, including a spacious, worldclass terminal building, a wellmaintained 3000m long and 45m wide runway equipped with navigational aids, airfield lighting for precision approaches, and taxiway systems capable of handling large aircraft. Additionally, it offers cutting-edge air traffic control facilities and technology-driven solutions to enhance operational efficiency. GBIA provides a wide range of traveler-centric

facilities, including CUPPS-enabled check-in counters, customs and immigration services, lounges, retail shops, restaurants, and local travel-related services, ensuring a comfortable and convenient experience for passengers.



ON JANUARY 1, 2023, POKHARA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT OPENED FOR INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT OPERATIONS, FURTHER ENHANCING THE INFRASTRUCTURE AVAILABLE FOR AIR CONNECTIVITY WITHIN AND BEYOND NEPAL. THE AIRPORT IS EXPECTED TO HANDLE ONE MILLION PASSENGERS PER YEAR. IT FEATURES A 2500M LONG RUNWAY, ICAO 4D CATEGORY, WITH ILS PRECISION APPROACH CAT-1 (PA1) FACILITY. THE APRON CAN ACCOMMODATE THREE B737 OR EQUIVALENT-SIZED AIRCRAFT AND EIGHT ATR72/DASH8 TYPE AIRCRAFT.

Since its inauguration, Jazeera Airways operated scheduled international flights from GBIA in the Kuwait – Bhairahawa (OKKK – VNBW) sector until April 19, 2024. Himalaya Airlines commenced 68 charter flights between Bhairahawa and Kuala Lumpur (VNBW – WMKK) starting from November 3, 2022, and Nepal Airlines started its scheduled flights from Kuala Lumpur to Bhairahawa (WMKK – VNBW) on June 13, 2024, continuing to serve the Kuala Lumpur – Bhairahawa – Kathmandu (WMKK – VNBW – VNKT) route. Notably, GBIA is gaining popularity among private charter flights, while Pokhara is still awaiting airlines to serve the airport.

However, the two international airports outside Kathmandu now are waiting for scheduled international flights. Despite offering full waivers on landing, parking, and navigation charges for international flights, GBIA and PIA have not yet attracted the expected number of airlines. Recognizing the need to reevaluate their incentive mechanisms, efforts are underway to create tailored incentive packages that reduce operational costs for interested airlines. These initiatives include improved ground handling, flight catering, and hangar/housing options.

Meanwhile, Nepal's airports have introduced several initiatives to enhance passenger experiences, including:


PASSENGER-CENTRIC SERVICES:

Improved information dissemination through digital displays and mobile apps providing real-time updates on flight statuses.

Free Wi-Fi service, news and entertainment options, kids play areas, baby feeding rooms, and medical facilities.

Introduction of premium lounges, better dining options, and retail experiences to cater to diverse passenger needs.

Contactless Services: Terminal entry, check-in/self-check-in, security screening, payment options, and boarding passes are now facilitated through contactless technologies to ensure a smooth and efficient passenger processing experience.





Enhanced Comfort: Airports are focusing on the comfort and convenience of passengers by offering better seating arrangements in waiting areas and lounges, ensuring that passengers have a pleasant and relaxing experience while waiting for their flights.

Customer Assistance: Trained staff are available to assist passengers with special needs, ensuring that everyone, including elderly travelers and those with disabilities, receives the necessary support.

TECHNOLOGY INTEGRATION:

Mobile Applications: Dedicated mobile applications have been launched to provide passengers with real-time updates on flight statuses, gate information, and other important notifications

Automated Systems: The introduction of automated systems for check-in, baggage drop, and passport control helps in reducing queues and wait times, making the entire process more efficient.


SUSTAINABILITY INITIATIVES:



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Koshi Tappu Wildlife Reserve lies on the floodplains of the Sapta Koshi River in the southeastern Terai. The reserve was gazetted in 1976 to preserve habitat for the only remaining population of Wild buffalo, Arna (Bubalus arnee). The 176 sq. km. reserve is Nepal's smallest wildlife reserve. The eastern and western embankments of the Sapta Koshi River define the area. In 1987, Koshi Tappu was declared a Ramsar site, a wetland of international significance. Government of Nepal has declared the buffer zone (173.5 sq. km) surrounding the reserve in 2004. The reserve is also home to around 20 other animal species such as Hog deer ,Wild boar , Spotted deer, Blue bull, and Rock Python. Around 441 species of birds-many seen now here else in Nepal (14 endemic species) have been recorded, including 20 duck species , 2 lbis species, white tailed stonechat , Striated marsh warbler, 30 shore birds, 114 water birds, and the endangered swamp partridge and Bengal florican.

Gyanendra Malla, former captain of the Nepal national cricket team is currently the head coach of the Nepal A team. Malla made his senior debut against Namibia in 2006 & was part of Nepal's first T20 World Cup as well as ODI squad. He retired from international cricket in 2023, leaving a legacy as a key player in Nepal's cricket history. We recently caught up with Malla to discuss his cricketing journey and Nepali cricket. Excerpts:

I am happy where I am now, and likewise, I am happy with where the current national team is now.

Now coming to our current squad, the team has the skills and hunger to win. Our goal was to qualify for the next World Cup in 2016, and there was a strong belief that the team was ready for it. However, an earthquake hit the country in 2015, disrupting our plans. Despite recent World Cup experience and a solid team with a few new players, we missed the qualification. In the previous World Cup qualifier in Oman, the team came close but ultimately did not qualify. Now, the breakthrough has finally been achieved in 2024.

THE CURRENT WORLD CUP QUALIFYING TEAM DIFFERS SIGNIFICANTLY FROM THE PREVIOUS ONE. MAINLY, CRICKET HAS CHANGED A LOT FROM 2014 TO 2024 IN TERMS OF SKILL, COMMERCIAL ASPECTS, AND FAN BASE. DUE TO THESE CHANGES, I CAN PROUDLY SAY THAT ALMOST 30 MILLION NEPALI PEOPLE WATCH CRICKET. BEFORE 2014, ONLY A FEW PEOPLE COULD RELATE TO CRICKET, BUT THE FIRST WORLD CUP GREW THE NUMBER OF NEPALI FOLLOWERS, AND NOW THE SPORT HAS EVERYONE'S ATTENTION.

Currently, we have a much more skillful team. Similarly, the T2O format has changed and become more aggressive. Previously, a total score of 140-160 runs used to be good and could help you win matches. Though the 2024 World Cup has seen low scores due to field conditions, using the IPL as a benchmark, teams are easily scoring 230-240. Likewise, we have already seen teams scoring 100 runs in powerplays. The changes are ongoing, and our team is catching up.



Back in 2014, we didn't have ODI status, but now we do. Our current team has also gained significant exposure, which is good and something we fought for. Coming to 2024, the biggest achievement is that the entire 30 million population understands the game, which is the best part.


The teams before us laid the foundation, and we continued to build on it, making Nepali cricket what it is today. This gives me immense joy and makes me feel extremely proud to have been able to contribute my part.

In terms of development, we have reached every corner of the country with cricket, establishing ourselves as an ODI nation. We have retained our ODI status, played in the Asia Cup, and qualified for the T20 World Cup. Our on-field development is evident, and off the field, the CAN management is also evolving and growing. They are putting in significant effort, setting up an A-team, organizing under-19 games, conducting national tournaments, and enhancing the cricketing structure and revenue. Additionally, corporations are progressing, and most importantly, the government is showing strong support.

For the first time in the sports history of Nepal, projects related to sports have been included in the projects of national pride, which are three cricket stadiums. This is a positive sign of cricket's growth and government support. The ICC also supports various aspects, and we have a team composed entirely of native players. The game is growing, and I see good developments happening.

Regarding the strengths and challenges of the current squad, the way we are currently playing is impressive. The team spirit and unity are very strong, and we are proving ourselves as a top associate nation. However, a major challenge is the lack of exposure to playing conditions abroad. Playing and winning against big teams abroad has been a weakness so far. We need to improve in these areas. The more international exposure the players get, the stronger and more cohesive the team will become.

The development of bench strength, the growth of the under-19 team, and the A squad will provide the necessary exposure to playing conditions abroad, particularly in the UK, US, Canada, or even Australia.

THE ONLY MOTIVATION FACTOR FOR THEM IS YOUR HOPE AND LOVE. SO. PLEASE KEEP SUPPORTING THE TEAM AND. IF POSSIBLE. LET'S CONTRIBUTE TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE SPORT WITH ALL **OUR LITTLE EFFORTS.**

Sending players to play season-long cricket individually in these countries will help them learn their responsibilities and build their character. We can keep track of U19 player's performance to ensure they are included as crucial team members rather than just fillers.

Talking about our fan following, we are blessed to have such a passionate and energetic fan base. They are amazing, and wherever we go and play, we are backed. Their presence gives us a homely atmosphere no matter where we play. Meanwhile, the number has grown immensely in the recent years. Their passionate support for the national team shows that the whole nation stands for the country. I want to thank them from the core of my heart for the effort they bring in to motivate the team. A lot of our fans travelled to the US to support the team, covering huge distances, which shows their dedication towards the team. Besides, they are also willing to provide all kinds of support for the development of cricket.



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


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
